ABORIGINAL STUDY AWARD FOR 1980-1981

Applications are invited for the above scholarship. The purpose of the Award is to further the education and experience of an Aboriginal woman graduate in any field of study and/or to assist a woman graduate (Aboriginal or non-Aboriginal) whose proposed project or course of study may ultimately benefit the Australian Aboriginal people. The scholarship is open to all women who are graduates of an Australian University or who have equivalent qualifications from another tertiary institution in Australia. Applications will also be considered from women who have not yet taken out their degrees. The scholarship is for full-time study or research or work on a specific project in any country on any subject (within the scope of the purpose of the award).

The scholarship is to the value of \$A2,500 and is tenable for a period of 12 months (or for a period approved by Federal Council). The scholarship money will be paid in two parts. Half the amount will be paid to the successful applicant on the commencement of her project and the remainder on receipt by Federal Council of a satisfactory interim report midway through the period of the grant. A more detailed report will be required within 3 months of completion of the scholarship's duration.

An applicant in receipt of a salary or holding another scholarship or grant concurrently is not necessarily disqualified from receiving the scholarship but the amount of such salary or grant must be stated and will be taken into consideration when the award is made.

The award of the scholarship shall be made by Federal Council whose decision is final. In any publication resulting from the work carried out during the tenure of the scholarship acknowledgment of the assistance given by A.F.U.W. shall be made. Application shall be made to the A.F.U.W. through its member Association in the state in which the applicant resides. As there is no printed form of application the candidate is asked to submit the following information *in duplicate*:-

1. Name, address and phone number (if any)
2. Age.
3. Small photograph.
4. Medical Certificate.
5. Detailed report of academic record and work experience.
6. A letter guaranteeing at least a provisional place from the university or approved institution at which the applicant proposes to work.
7. An outline of the proposed area of study.
8. Names and addresses of two persons who have personal knowledge of the applicant's work and who are willing to act as referees.
9. A statement from the Treasurer of the State Association of A.F.U.W. stating that the applicant is a financial member of the Association.

Candidates must lodge their applications with the State Association by 31st May, 1980.

The Award will be announced during September 1980.
