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BLACK BOOKS*

The Centre for Black Books has been established to provide a bookshop service, mail order and distribution network for books by and about Aboriginal people.

The experience at Tranby Aboriginal College has shown there is no ready supply of Aboriginal books. There is also a need to keep teachers and academics as well as the general public up to date on the availability and quality of publications. There are many books in bookshops, schools and libraries which perpetuate racist attitudes. Aboriginal Studies is being slowly introduced into schools, colleges and universities, but there is overall ignorance of the authenticity of Aboriginal texts and their general content.

Black Books' long-term aim is to serve Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal students, teachers, educational establishments and community members throughout Australia.

Black Books centre is part of the Co-operative for Aborigines which is responsible for Tranby Aboriginal College.
